




# Reca Online Beed Bead & Grystal Specialist Repote Egg Rerfect Repote Egg Stuffing

1. One Peyote Egg is stuffed with 2 foam balls cut into 4 pieces (except for the small Egg of 7 rows, this needs only 1 ball - cut in half). They will be packaged vacuum. Please leave them out for a while to regain their shape.

15 stands for a 15 rows triangle Peyote Egg.


The finished Peyote Egg will be about 9x6 cm/3.5x2.4 inch.

This tutorial is for stuffing the 11 and 15 rows Peyote Egg. For an egg of 7 rows: follow the same steps, except for the use of the 2 smaller discs.



Before you stuff the Peyote Egg, push all the triangles outwards.


2. Take one of the smaller pieces and pinch the disc as shown in the picture. Place it in the Peyote Egg with the flat side facing up. Push it all the way to the bottom with your thumb as shown in the picture.





3. Take one of the bigger pieces and place it in the Peyote Egg with the flat side facing up. Push it all the way in and make sure it's below the middle line as shown in the picture.



4. Place the second big foamball on top of the first one with the flat surfaces against eachother.

6. Push the whole second big piece in.

It looks like it won't fit, but it will. Just do it slowly and with care.





7. Zip up /close one side.

8. Optional: pinch the second small disc and push it under the closed side. Using the last piece is a bit more difficult to zip closed.

If you don't use the last piece, the difference is not so much visible, but when you touch the bottom of the Peyote Egg, you will feel an empty space.
