



Perfect Peyote Star Stuffing

Step 1



Lay down all 13 pieces of the filling.

Once you have beaded all the warped squares, connect (zip up) 4 of them.

Step 2



Pinch the smallest triangles and push them as far as you can in each point of the star. Place them with the two flaps up and down, so they fill up the points really well.

Using this technique, fill the three points that you have.

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Step 3



Take the larger triangles and push them on top of the smaller triangles in each point. Use your thumbs to push them in as far as you can without force. Fill each of the 3 points that you have so far:

Step 4



Connect/zip the last warped square on one side and fill the 4th point with the small and large triangles as described in step 2-3.

Step 5



Now take the large pentagon and push it in the middle of the star. Use 2 thumbs to push it all the way in. You might think there is no room for this, but the foam is really deformable.



Step 6



Take one of the squares and place it on top of the large pentagon in the middle of the star. Use your thumb to push it in. Do the same with the other square on the other side of the pentagon.

Step 7



Connect/zip the last warped square on the other side until the top of the point and fill the 5th point with the large triangle.

Step 8



Push the smallest triangle in the tip of the 5th point and connect/zip the warped square all the way down. Keep the point closed while you sew for the best result. And your star is stuffed!
